A significant feature in many of today’s portable ultrasound devices is their ability to connect with hospitals and physicians on shore via WIFI- allowing for remote overreading & expert real-time treatment guidance when precious seconds count. Upgrades in high-frequency scanning can (now) collect far deeper images in the body with the electronic means of “bringing the virtual doctor” at your side.
